Elmwood Community Foundation

The Elmwood Cultural Arts and Learning Center Board of Directors took action to guarantee that the future of our community continues to be enriched for generations to come.

On October 27, the members voted to become the official board for the new Elmwood Community Foundation. This foundation will serve under the Midlands Community Foundation, which provides many benefits including proven investment success, preparation of financial and compliance documentation, legal and marketing assistance for all charitable funds, and matching funds for gifts received between December 1 and January 5.

As an affiliate fund of Midlands Community Foundation, other local organizations can join under the "umbrella" of Elmwood Community Foundation and receive the same benefits of membership. The Bess Streeter Aldrich Foundation and American Legion Post #247 have already

agreed to do this. Each will invest the initial investment of \$5,000 (during the match period). We anticipate many other local organizations will also join in the near future.

The Elmwood Community Foundation requires an initial \$5,000 investment, too. Here is the amazing news. The Foundation has received a gift from an anonymous donor to do just that! This same benefactor has agreed to donate up to \$10,000 more if matching funds are secured. These funds (if donated during the match period) will have the potential to earn nearly \$25,000 for the foundation. This may enable the Foundation to add heating/air conditioning to the learning center while growing our funds for museum renovations, future expansion, and assistance for other local entities. 


